The CPD will cover topics on Emerging Issues in Food Animal Health and Production.

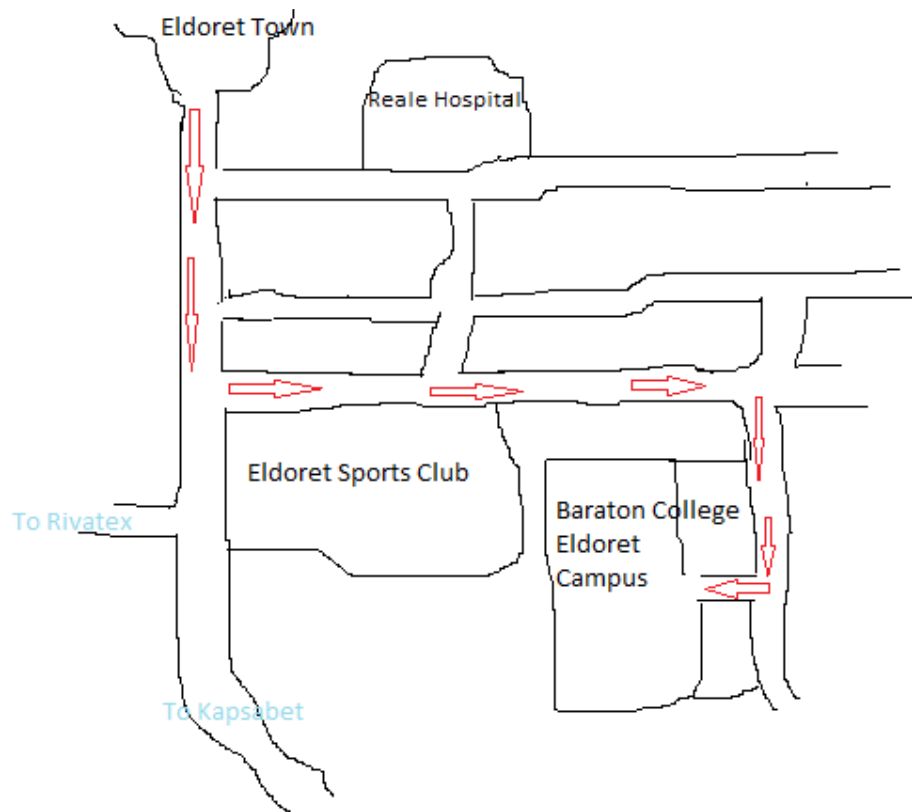
#### **Expected Attendees**
